



Update: Planned Closures on the Gulf Development Road & Kennedy Development Road

Etheridge Shire Council has received advice from the Department of Transport & Main Roads Cairns Regional Office.

The single lane bridges will be closed to all traffic between <u>7pm and 5am</u> <u>Monday to Saturday morning</u>. Works will be carried out intermittently from <u>Tuesday 7 May 2024</u> and be completed <u>Tuesday 4 June 2024</u>, weather and construction conditions permitting. Speed reductions will be in place at the sites outside these hours.

<u>Gulf Developmental Road</u> – <u>Night works between 7pm and 5am from 7 May</u> to 31 May

<u>Kennedy Developmental Road (The Lynd and Hughenden)</u> - Hospital Creek will be Night works in late May – early June and further details will be provided.

Work crews will ensure Emergency Services are provided access through the work site, where required.

Variable Message Signs (VMS) will be in place to advise motorists about the closures so they can plan their journeys in the following locations:

• GDR - Normanton, Mt Garnet, Georgetown, Mt. Surprise and Einasleigh
