Inclement weather and flood warning #3

Issued by the Etheridge Local Disaster Management Group at 8.30am on 6th January 2023.

The Etheridge Shire Local Disaster Management Group (LDMG) continues to monitor recent rainfall activity across the Shire. Steady, but heavy rainfall associated with a tropical low fell across the Shire's river catchments overnight. This has led to significant rises in water levels in dam storages and river systems.

Road networks have been affected. The Gulf Development Road remains closed at the Gilbert River Bridge. Other river crossings along the Shire's highways may experience periodic closures as catchment waters pass through the river systems. Motorists are recommended to exercise caution, check road conditions ahead, obey all traffic control signs and do not attempt to cross flooded crossings.

As conditions allow and staff return from leave, Council's roads crews will soon start emergency repairs to re-open the Shire's road network. We ask for resident's patience as this occurs.

Shire residents that may be running low of essential food and medical supplies are advised to contact the Council Administration office on 4079 9090.

The Local Disaster Management Group recommend: -

- Travellers are advised to check road conditions on <u>www.131940.qld.gov.au</u> and review their travel plans if roads are closed.
- Residents and motorists are strongly advised not to enter, walk or drive through floodwaters.
- For flood and storm emergency assistance, call the State Emergency Service (SES) on 132 500.
- If your life is in danger, call Triple Zero (000) immediately.
