

PUBLIC NOTICE

1080 Baiting Notice

Etheridge Shire Council wish to advise residents and visitors that the 1080 poison baiting campaign will be conducted throughout the Etheridge Shire from 15th to 26th May 2023. All properties that are participating in the campaign are required by Law to display *1080 Baiting* warning signs at all entrances to their land that is being baited and the extremities of their land fronting a public thoroughfare or visible to a person in the public space such as a roadside rest stop.

Etheridge Shire Council advises residents and visitors travelling with pets or working dogs to keep them contained/restrained & if possible, muzzles should be fitted, particularly whilst camping or while the animal is outside the vehicle for whatever reason in rural areas to minimize the opportunities for the animal to come in contact with poison baits.

Please take note of any warning signs whilst travelling the Etheridge Shire and take care as we wish your memories of your visit to our shire to be pleasant ones.
