Caution is urged if traversing flooded creek crossings as road surfaces may be damaged, submerged matter may not be clearly visible and underlying currents can be swift. Road shoulders of sealed roads generally become soft and slippery during heavy rain events and movement off the bitumen seal is discouraged.

**Please Note:** Etheridge Shire Council road reports only apply to the roads within the Etheridge Shire boundary and not neighbouring shires.
