Routh Creek Bridge – Gulf Developmental Road (Georgetown to Mt Garnet)

The Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) will be undertaking essential repair works on **Routh Creek Bridge**, Gulf Developmental Road (Georgetown – Mt Garnet) from **Monday 27 October 2025 until early December 2025**.

The works will include excavation of the existing bridge surface, replacement and installation of concrete relieving slabs, reinstatement of guardrail, road markings, and abutment protection. These works are being carried out to improve safety for motorists at this location.

Day works will take place from **Monday 27 October 2025**, between **7:00am and 5:00pm**, continuing until **Friday 5 December 2025**.

Night works will commence from **Tuesday 11 November 2025**, for **two nights between 9:00pm and 3:00am**, subject to site and weather conditions.

The night works will involve a temporary **full closure of Routh Creek Bridge** from **9:00pm**, with the bridge reopening to traffic each day from **3:00am**. Temporary full closures will end at **3:00am Thursday, 13 November 2025**.

Traffic control and reduced speed limits will be in place for the safety of road users and maintenance crews. Motorists are asked to observe all signage and directions at the site.

TMR has emergency arrangements in place should access be required during the works.

These recovery works are jointly funded by the Australian and Queensland Governments under the **Disaster Recovery Funding Arrangements (DRFA)**.
